

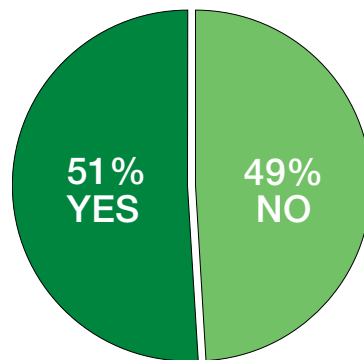
## U.S. workers prefer their own vehicles over public transportation.

### Is public transportation available for your commute to work?

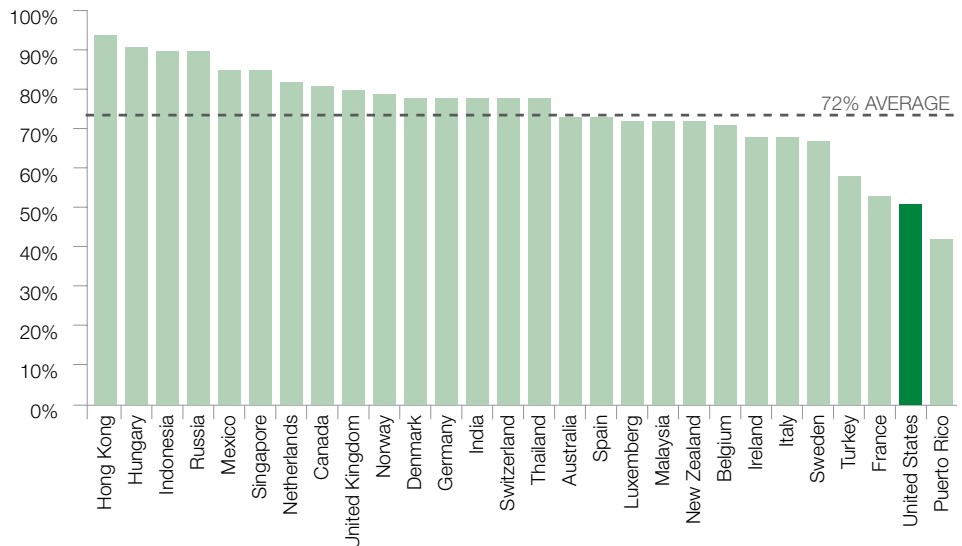
#### AVAILABILITY OF PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION IN THE US

51% of employees surveyed in the US perceive public transportation to be available for their commute to work.



#### AVAILABILITY OF PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION BY COUNTRY

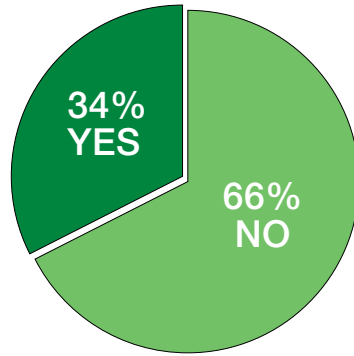
Globally, the US ranks 28th in perceived availability of public transportation; 21% behind the global average of 72%.



## Do you choose to use public transportation rather than your own vehicle?

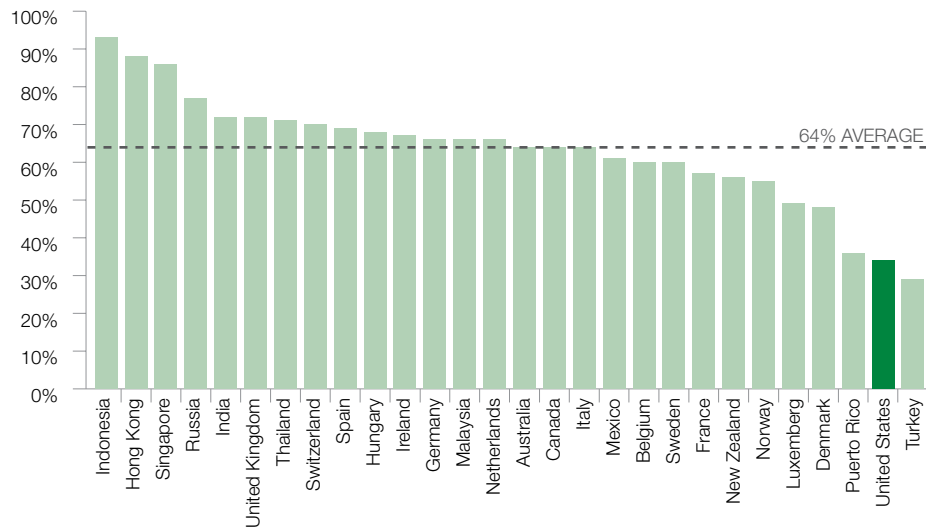
### PREFERENCE OF PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION IN USA

Only **34% American's with access to public transportation choose to use it** over their own vehicle for their daily commute.



### PREFERENCE OF PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION BY COUNTRY

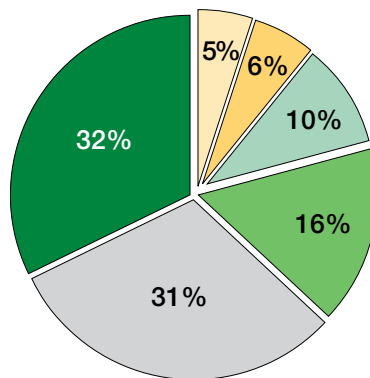
The US ranks **28th in public transportation as a preferred method of commuting to work**; 30% behind the global average of 64%.

Americans cite **convenient access** and **frequency of service** as the biggest issues in choosing public transportation.
